- doing what they want



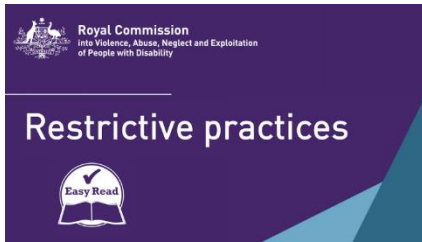
The Royal Commission wants to understand restrictive practices.

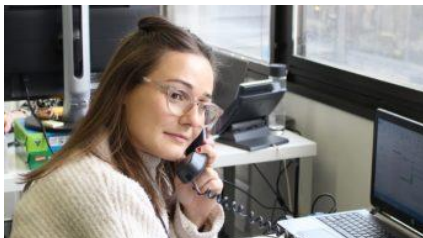
