The theme this year was **Leave No One Behind**.

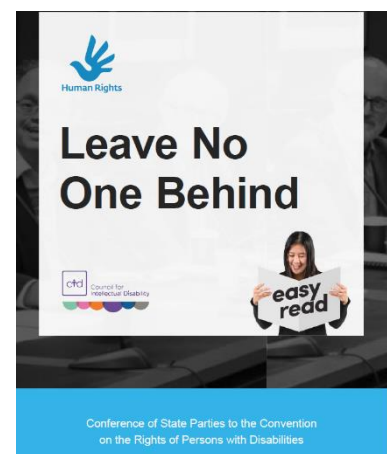


The United Nations and COSP is not good at including people with intellectual disability.
