I asked the Manager Craig how I could get a job at the cinema. He told me to fill out an application form.

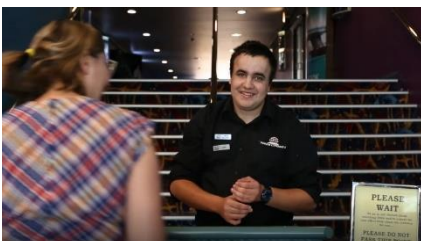
I had an interview and I got the job. I was so excited.
