

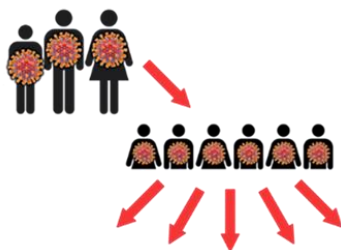
The Royal Commission and Coronavirus COVID-19

Coronavirus can spread when people are close to each other.

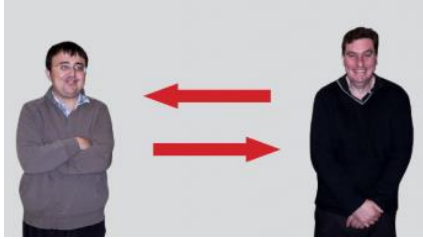
It can spread at public events.

They will hold public events again when it is safe.

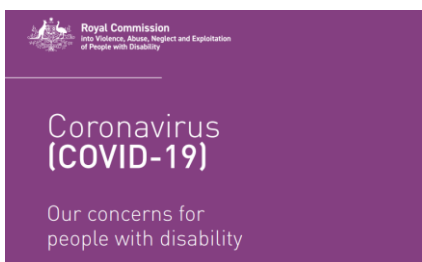

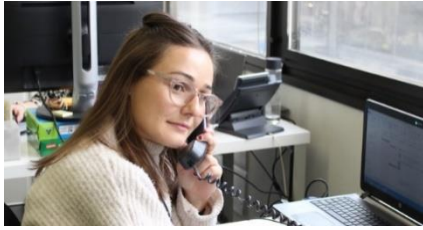
