The AA9s formed in 2021 and are part of a program the Randwick City Football Club created in 2010 to provide people with a disability the opportunity to play football and be part of the sporting community in the Eastern Suburbs.

The AA9s play against non-disabled teams in competitions organised by the Eastern Suburbs Football Association. Competitions generally start after easter and run until end of August.

AA9s is open to men 16 years and over who want to give the game a go.

We don't knock anyone back and players can try out to see if it's for them. We have excellent coaches who'll do everything they can to ensure you have fun, get the most out of training, and develop as a player.
