One job is a Research Assistant at the Kirby Institute at UNSW.

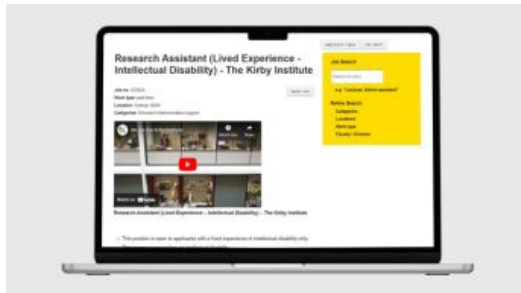


The project is about helping young people get vaccines at special schools.

We call it **the Centre** for short.

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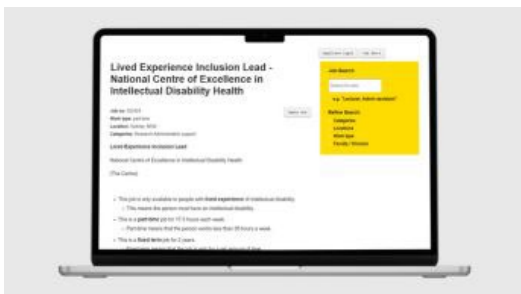


The job is about making sure that people with intellectual disability are leading work at the Centre.

It is called Stay off your phone!

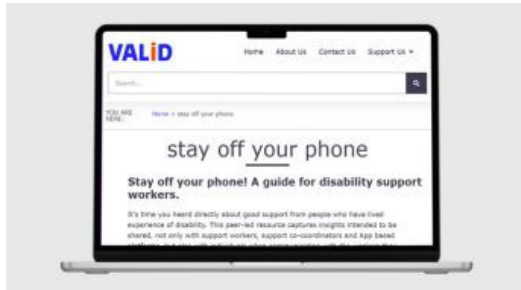


The guide talks about how support workers can do a better job supporting people with intellectual disability.
