An intellectual disability is **not** a health problem.




But we know that people with intellectual disability die younger than other people.

They made a 10 year plan to make health care better for people with intellectual disability.



The plan is called the **National Roadmap** for Improving the Health of People with Intellectual Disability.

We will say the National Roadmap for short.



The Governments gave money for the National Centre of Excellence in Intellectual Disability Health.

We will say the Centre for short.



The Centre works to make health care better for people with intellectual disability.



But these are just the first things the Government needed to do.



The Government should not stop working to make health care better for people with intellectual disability.

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The next Government needs to do all the things in the National Roadmap.

The DRC looked into lots of issues for people with intellectual disability.



- Training to learn how to support people with intellectual disability
- More time to give good care to people with intellectual disability.

We ask them to keep doing things to make health care better for people with intellectual disability.
