


## What the parties have said

## What we asked the political parties to do




We asked the political parties to do 4 things.



1. Keep working on the **National Roadmap for Improving the Health of People with Intellectual Disability.**

We say **National Roadmap** for short.



The National Roadmap is a 10 year plan to make health care better for people with intellectual disability.



There is still a lot of work to do on the National Roadmap.



2. Make sure doctors get training to support people with intellectual disability.



3. Make sure doctors have more time to spend with people with intellectual disability.



4. Make sure the next **National Health Reform Agreement** supports people with disability.

We say the **agreement** for short



The agreement is a plan to make health care better for all people in Australia.



We want the health of people with intellectual disability to be a big part of the plan.


# What the political parties told us they will do

They will keep working on the National Roadmap to make health care better for people for intellectual disability.




They will make sure health students learn how to support people with intellectual disability.
